


I wish to congratulate Miss Cooper and the Annual Staff upon the completion of this year book.



CHIP HICKS WILLS HIS ABILITY TO BE HIGH POINT MAN TO JERRY HALE.



Now WE MUST RETURN TO OUR BUSINESS AND HOME IN MIAMI SO WE'LL BID YOU ADIEU.


