Our first activity was a camping trip to North Piney Lake. The boys that went enjoyed the trip very much and are looking forward to the one next summer.

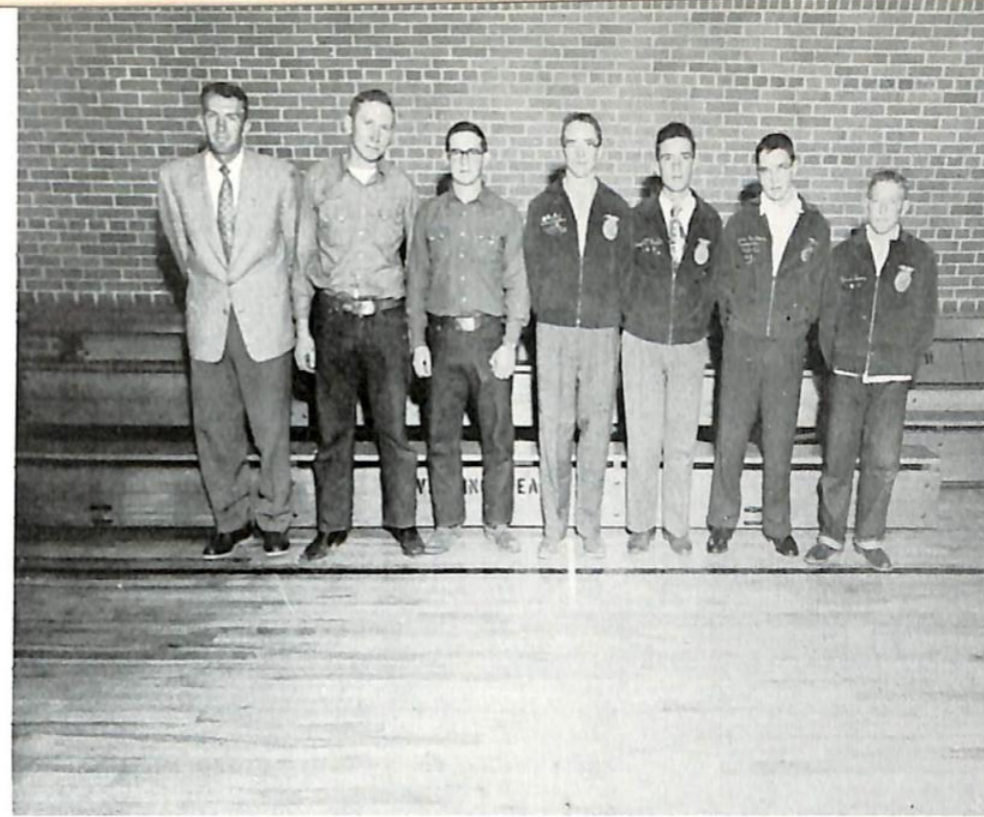
After school started in September, our judging team traveled to Laramie to the State F.F.A. judging convention.
