Our first activity was a camping trip to North Piney Lake. The boys that went enjoyed the trip very much and are looking forward to the one next summer.


After school started in September, our judging team traveled to Laramie to the State F.F.A.




There has been a great deal of improvement in the band this year due to the excellent work of Mr. Gallemore. We have been having concert band practice three days a week and drill work the other two.

We are looking forward to our yearly spring choral program to sing all of the song we've sung during the year under the direction of Mr. Gallemore.


