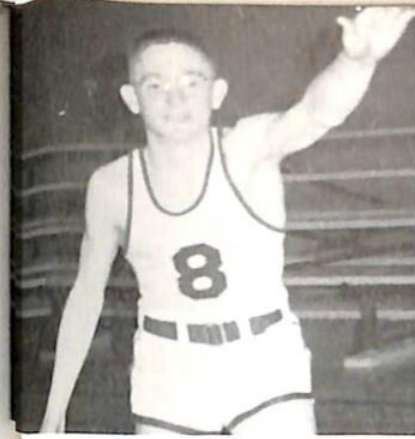
I am often reminded of a brave old Scot wounded in battle:

High School Ensemble

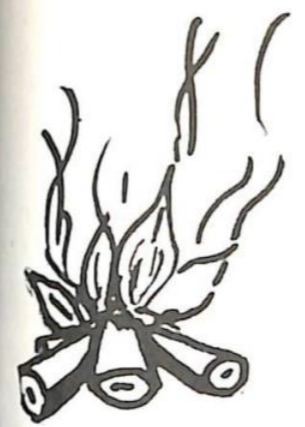
